(U) When you need a second pair of eyes on your "5-EYES"...

- (U) You have written up a document, but you aren't sure about the correct classification. You've looked in the <u>Classification Manual Frequently Asked Questions</u>, but still need some guidance from an expert. What do you do? -- Contact your SID Classification Advisory Officer (CAO).
