Course Overview:

(S) The combination of growing nuclear weapons capabilities and misperceptions or hostile intentions between Pakistan and India makes even minor incidents in Central Asia into potential nuclear conflagrations. A better understanding of the knowns and unknowns about Pakinstan's nuclear doctrine and capabilities is a starting point to solving the knowledge gaps on this important intelligence target. What are Pakistan's nuclear "red lines"? Who can order nuclear weapon's use? How are nuclear weapons secured and controlled? What nuclear delivery capabilities do Pakistani forces possess? We will look into these and other questions to help focus future intelligence efforts.
