...And regarding the article (U) Using an Intelligence Analysis Technique -- On Ourselves:

Comment: (U//FOUO) A growing number of organizations in government and industry, including NSA, are looking at using Social Network Analysis techniques to better understand the self-organizing social networks that are key to performance. Unlike the formal org chart, which documents roles and responsibilities, social network maps show the pattern of relationships through which work is actually done. The focus is on people rather than process, and collaboration rather than tasking. It is knowledge transfer pilot article presents one perspective on this approach.
